**RE: INVITATION TO SUBMIT SOLIDARITY STATEMENTS AND TO BRING ORGANISATIONAL BANNERS TO THE CONFERENCE OF THE LEFT**

Dear Comrades

Revolutionary greetings from the Steering Committee of the Conference of the Left. As we move toward the convening of the Conference at the Birchwood Hotel from Friday 29 to Sunday 31 May 2026, we write to invite your organisation to submit a written statement of solidarity to the Conference.

The Conference is co-convened to rebuild working-class power from below, to strengthen unity across the left, and to forge a common programme rooted in the lived conditions of the working class and the poor. The solidarity statements of participating organisations form an important part of this collective expression. They record the voices of the formations that have come together for this convening, and they affirm the unity of purpose that brings us into one space.

We therefore ask that each organisation prepare and submit a solidarity statement **on or before Monday 25 May 2026**. Submitting your statement ahead of the Conference allows the Secretariat to collate all statements received into a single Solidarity Compendium, which will be included in the official Conference package provided to every delegate. Statements received after this date may not be possible to include in the printed package.

**To assist with preparation and collation, we suggest the following:**

- Keep the statement concise, ideally between one and two pages.
- Address the statement to the Conference of the Left and its participating formations.
- Speak to the unity of the left, the conditions facing the working class and the poor, and the tasks of the present period.
- Indicate clearly the name of the organisation and the name and designation of the comrade endorsing the statement on its behalf.
- Submit the statement in electronic form (Word or PDF) to the Secretariat at the contact details below.

Please send your solidarity statement to the Secretariat by email at [adminsec@sacp.org.za](mailto:adminsec@sacp.org.za). Should you require any clarification, the Secretariat is available to assist.

In addition, we warmly invite all participating organisations to bring their organisational banners to the Conference. Delegates are encouraged to arrive with their banners on the opening day, Friday 29 May 2026, so that they may be displayed in the plenary and around the venue. The presence of our banners together in one space is itself an expression of the unity and collective strength of the left.

We thank you for your continued commitment to the unity and renewal of the left, and we look forward to receiving your statement and to welcoming your organisation to the Conference.
